HOW TO APPLY



CCLS is authorized under federal law to enroll non-immigrant students with an F1 visa. You must apply for the student (F1)visa in your country if you plan to register for the Intensive English Program.

The student visa application process is very easy:

- Fill out the Application Form & the Financial Support Certificate
- Make a copy of the personal information page of your passport
- Show proof of financial support for your stay in the US
- Send all the documents to CCLS via email at info@cclscorp.com
- Pay the application fees

Send all the documents to info@cclscorp.com

CCLS will review the documents, issue the I-20 Form and mail it you.

After receiving the I-20, you can schedule your visa interview at the American embassy or consulate in your country.

CCLS has developed partnerships with several colleges and universities in Florida and throughout the United States.

Depending on the university or college, CCLS students who successfully complete the Intensive English Program with at least 75% grade are automatically accepted by the institution.

Some universities offer a "pathway program" into undergraduate or graduate studies; specifically for students who need additional academic preparation for Bachelor's, Master's or Doctorate's programs.

Occasionally, universities representatives also visit CCLS campus to do a presentation of their institution and courses offered.

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Our Academic Department will be happy to assist you choose and apply to college or university.

Fact: Several CCLS students have been accepted by a college or university without taking the TOEFL.



What's the minimum age to register?

The minimum age is 15. The average age FREQUENTLY of our students is 26.


